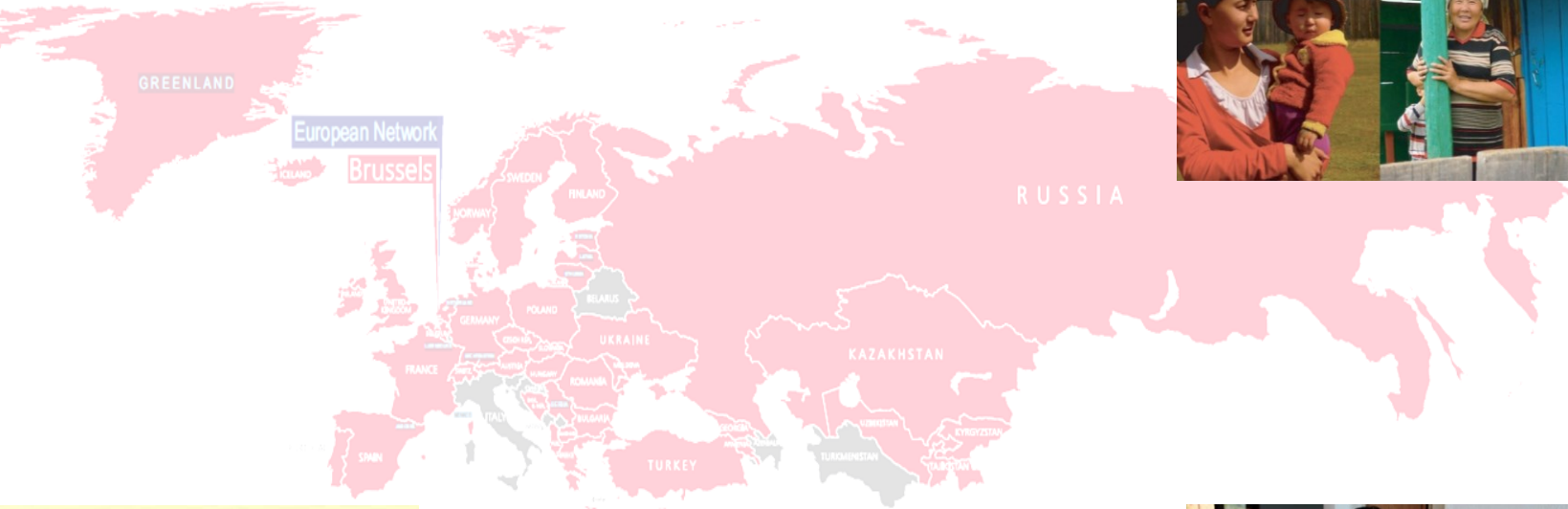

In 2015

16 EU countries were analysed on their policies on access to **MODERN CONTRACEPTIVE CHOICE**

Sexuality education is only mandatory in just over **50%** of the countries but it is insufficient as it lacks complete scientific information on the full range and use of contraceptives.

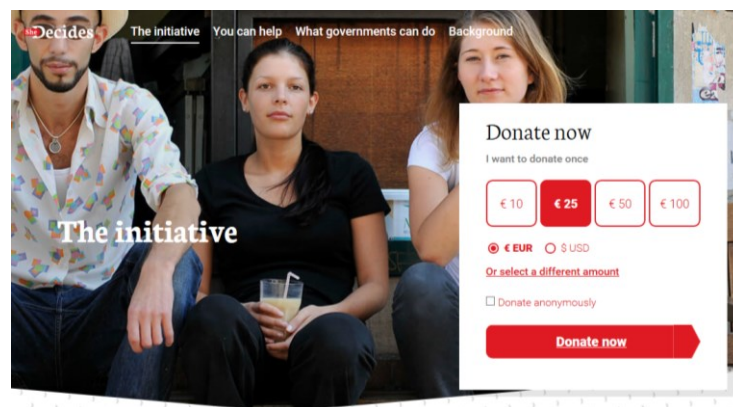

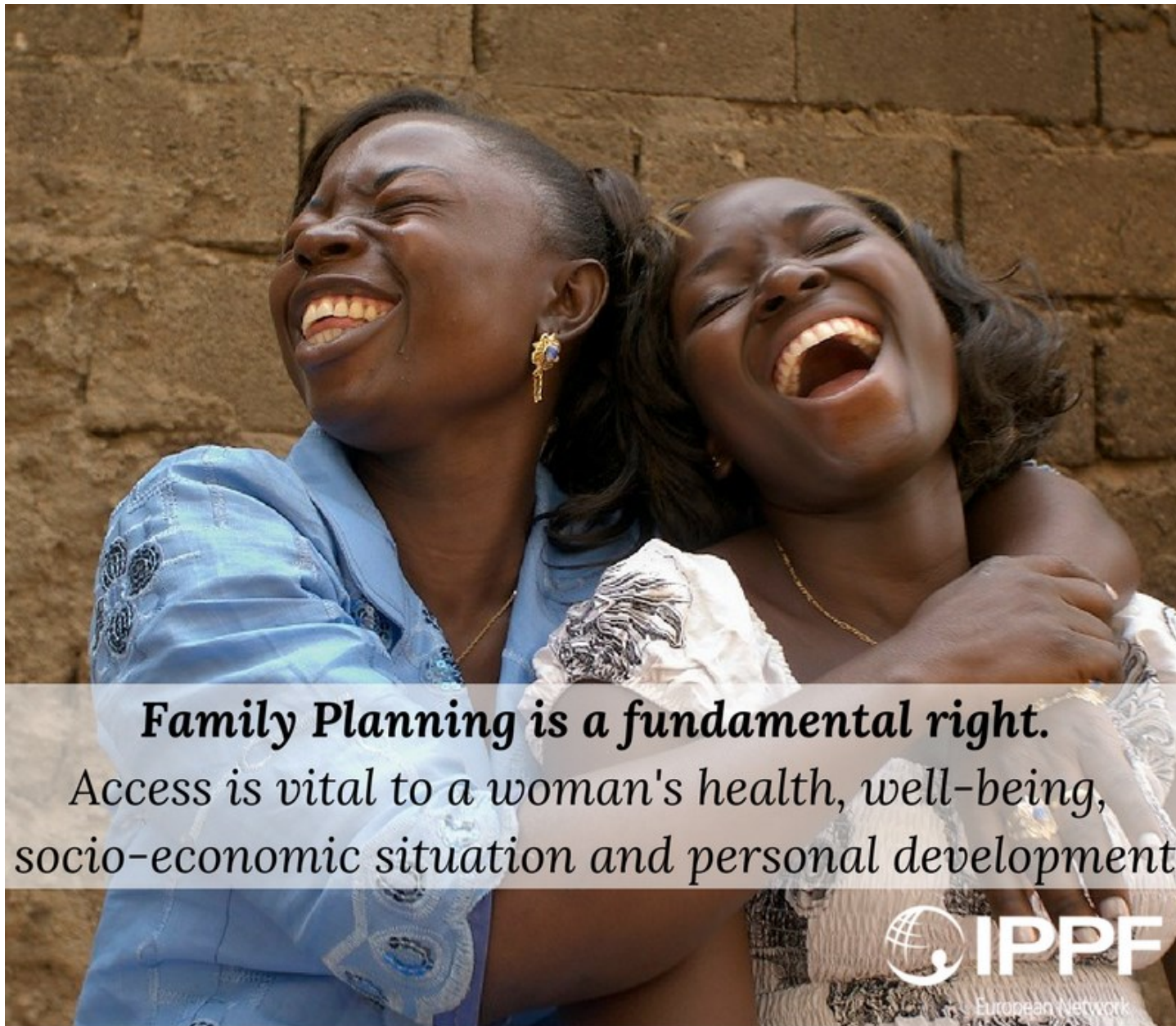

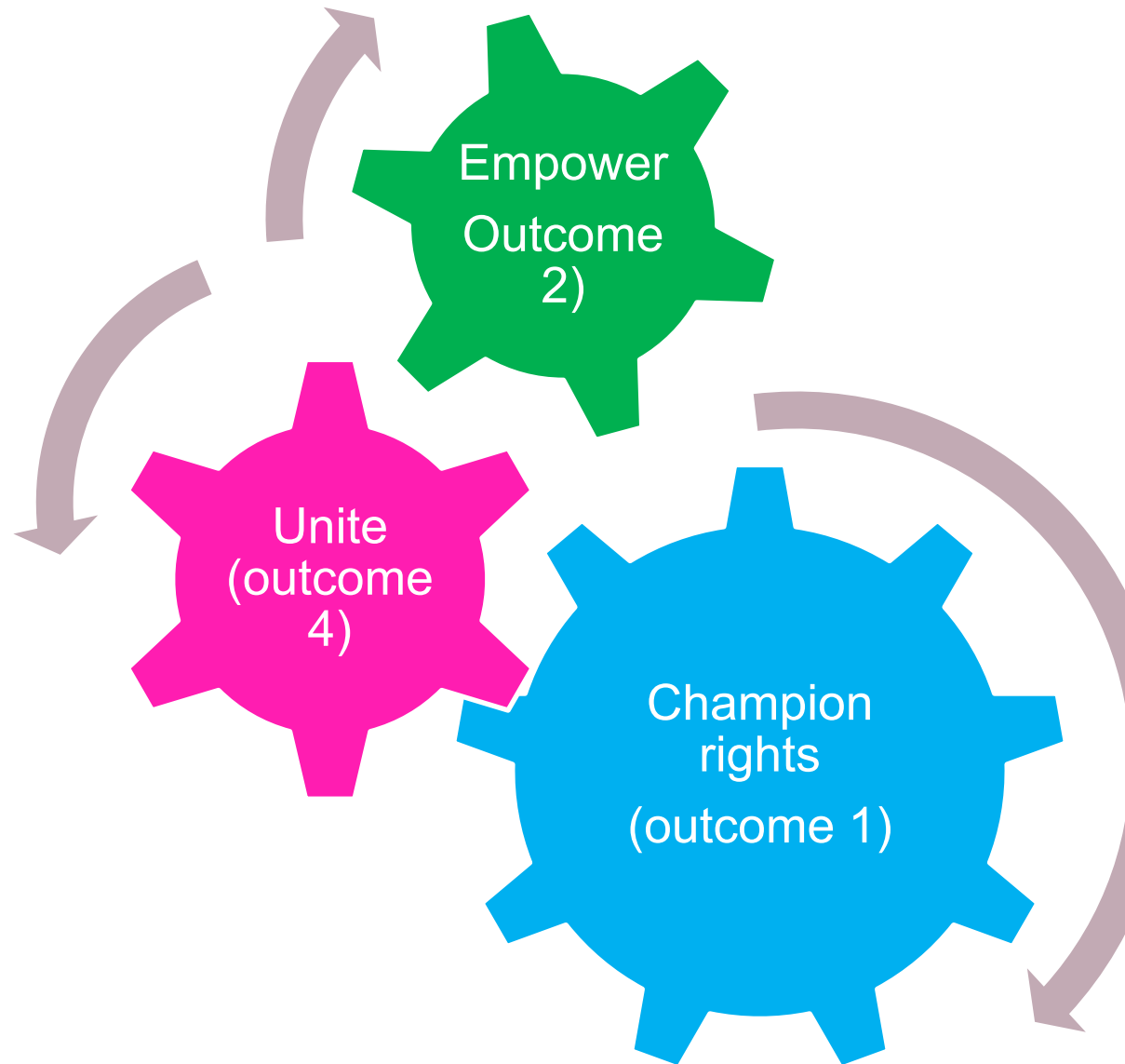
The She Decides initiative and conference offered the platform and the momentum to help shape a new global partnership for sexual and reproductive health and rights (SRHR).

Get your service and your practice effective, appropriate and attractive to young people by working with them and developing ways to reach out to and listen to them.

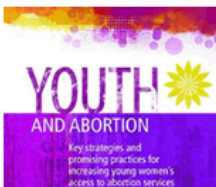

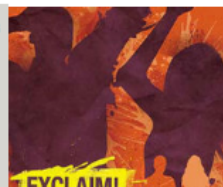
